PURPOSE OF TEST

To demonstrate that:

THE RIDER

Has attained sufficient knowledge and competence to execute the movements correctly and precisely.

THE HORSE

- a) Has acquired, in addition to those qualities of the Novice standard, greater muscular development, suppleness and impulsion to enable it to execute, with ease, the more demanding movements of the test.
- b) Shows a slightly higher rounded outline than at Novice level as a result of the increased engagement of the hind legs.
- c) At this standard, when asked for collection, riders are only expected to show sufficient engagement to carry out the required movements.

CONDITIONS

- a) The test will be conducted and judged in accordance with the B.H.S. Dressage Rules.
- b) To be ridden in a snaffle or simple bridle (see Dressage Rules) and with both hands. Transitions from one pace to another may be progressive, except where stated otherwise.
- c) All trot work to be ridden sitting.
- d) Penalties for errors over the course:
